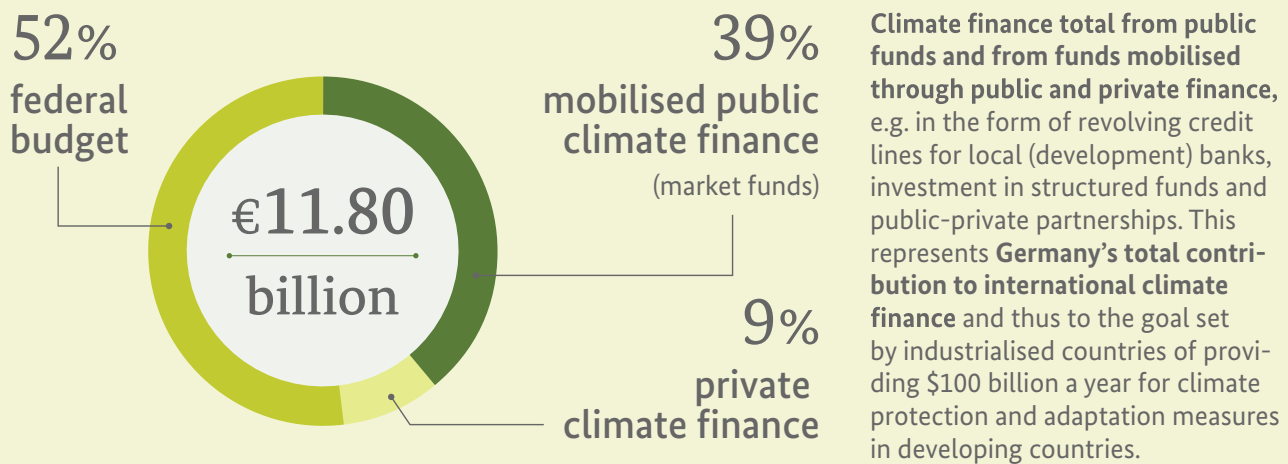

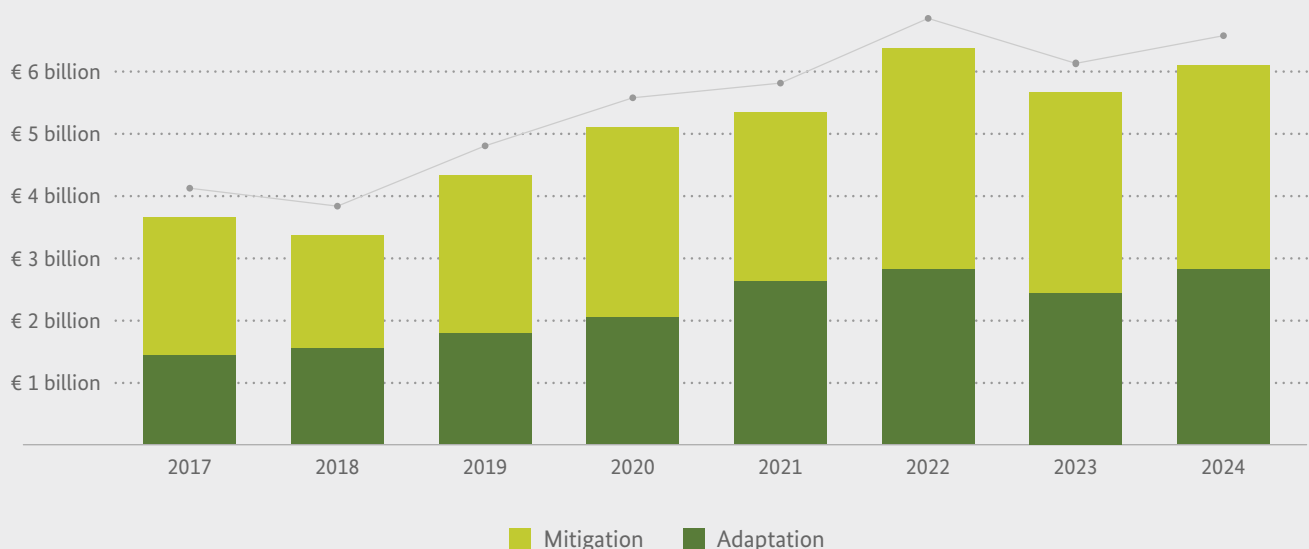


## Climate finance from federal budget 2024

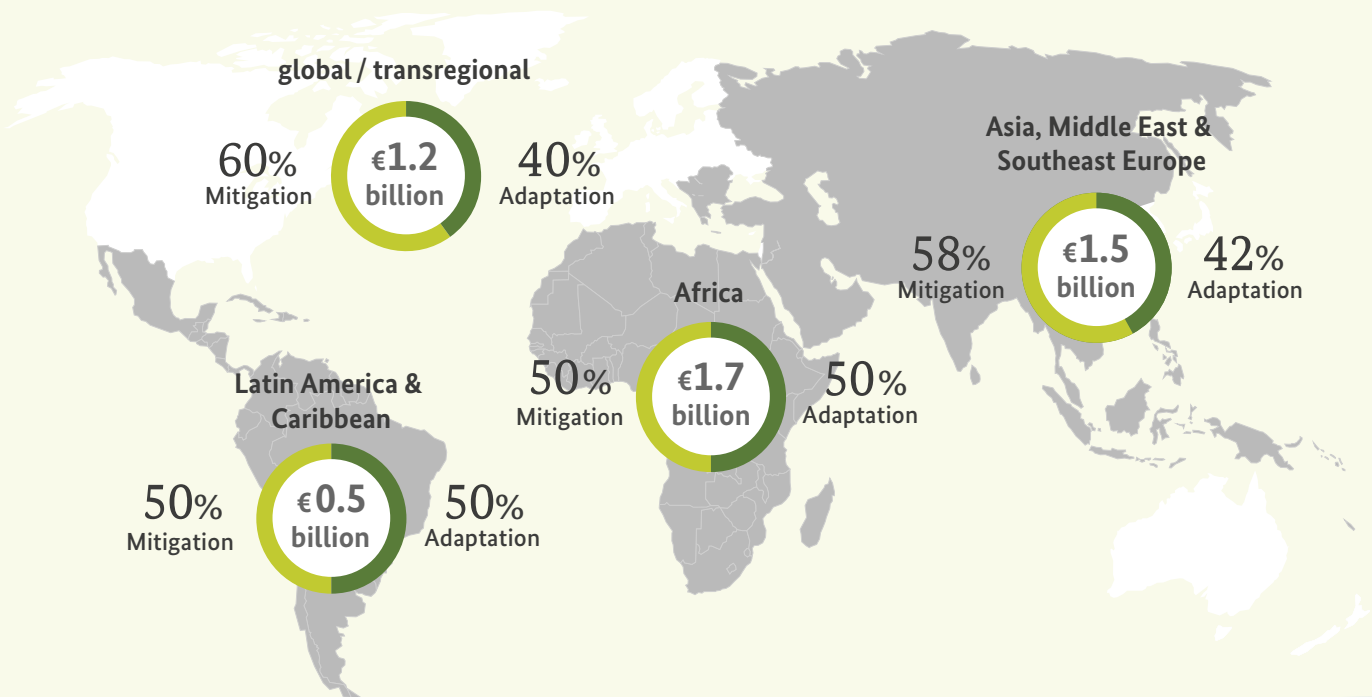

## Bilateral climate finance 2024 by region (federal budget)

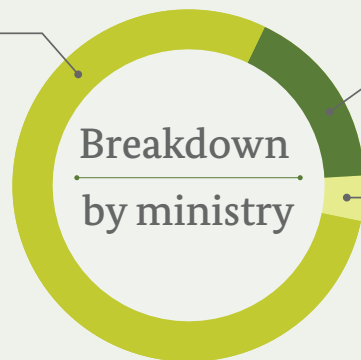


Germany channels most of its climate finance through bilateral cooperation. In 2024, around **80 per cent (4.88 billion euros)** of the budget allocated to climate finance went towards bilateral cooperation; the remaining **20 per cent (1.24 billion euros)** went towards the German government's multilateral activities.
